

AUBURN Downtown Revitalization Initiative Small Project Grant Program

Round Three

The third round of the Auburn Downtown Revitalization Initiative **Small Project Grant Fund** is intended to assist businesses and entrepreneurs in the DRI boundary. DRI grant funds will be dispersed on a reimbursement basis, meaning that the project costs will need to be expended and documented *prior to* receiving the funds.

There are two categories of funding available: **Entrepreneurial Seed Funding** (assistance for entrepreneurs and businesses operating for less than 1 year, with priority given to woman, minority and veteran-owned) and **Existing Business Assistance** (existing businesses operating more than 1 year). Match requirements differ per category and more details can be found by visiting **cayugaEDA.org/dri-round3**

This grant is administered by The Cayuga County Economic Development Agency, a nonprofit committed to serving the businesses of Cayuga County. Services include business advisement and resource connections, access to programs, incentives, benefits and more. Conversations are always free and confidential.

GRANTS UP TO \$50,000

Eligibility*

- Be located in the **DRI Boundary**
- Be locally owned (corporate chains and franchises are not eligible)
- Be current on all federal, state and local taxes
- Show a plan for and/or documented commitment of financing for 100% of the project cost
